Other functions: ♦

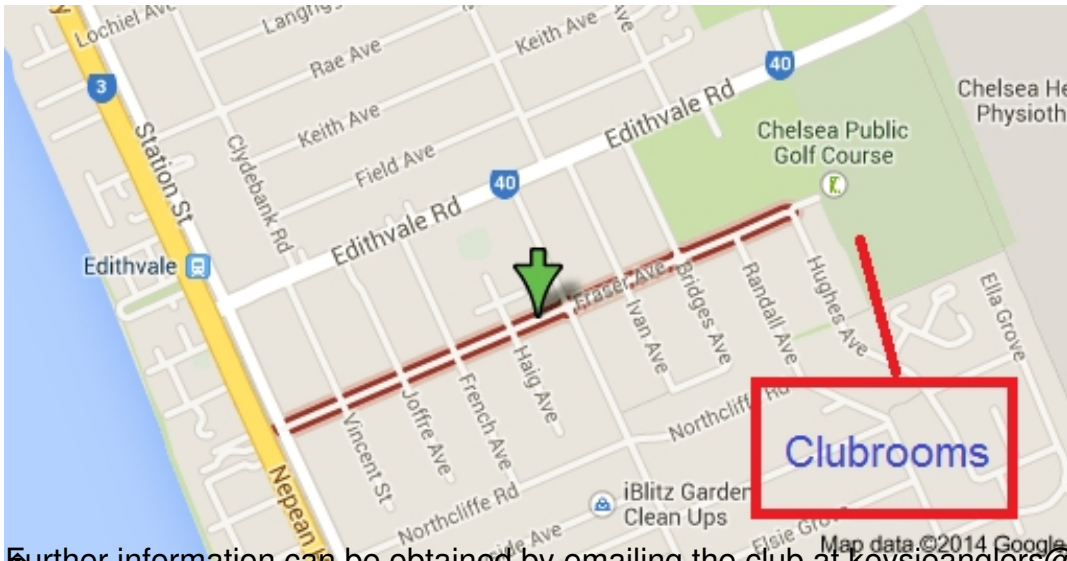
